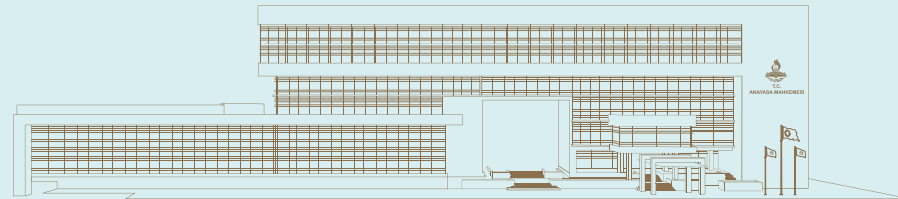

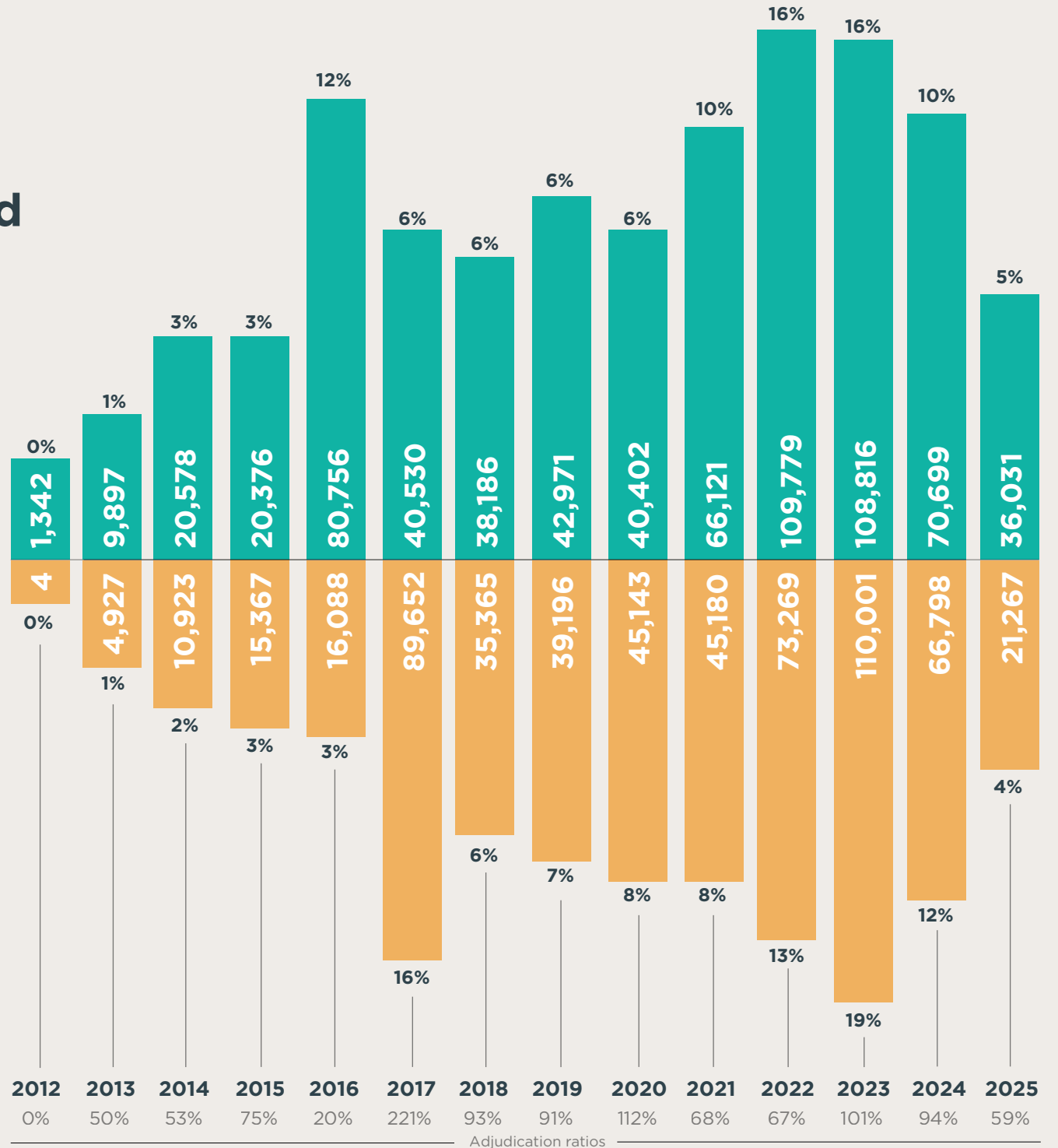

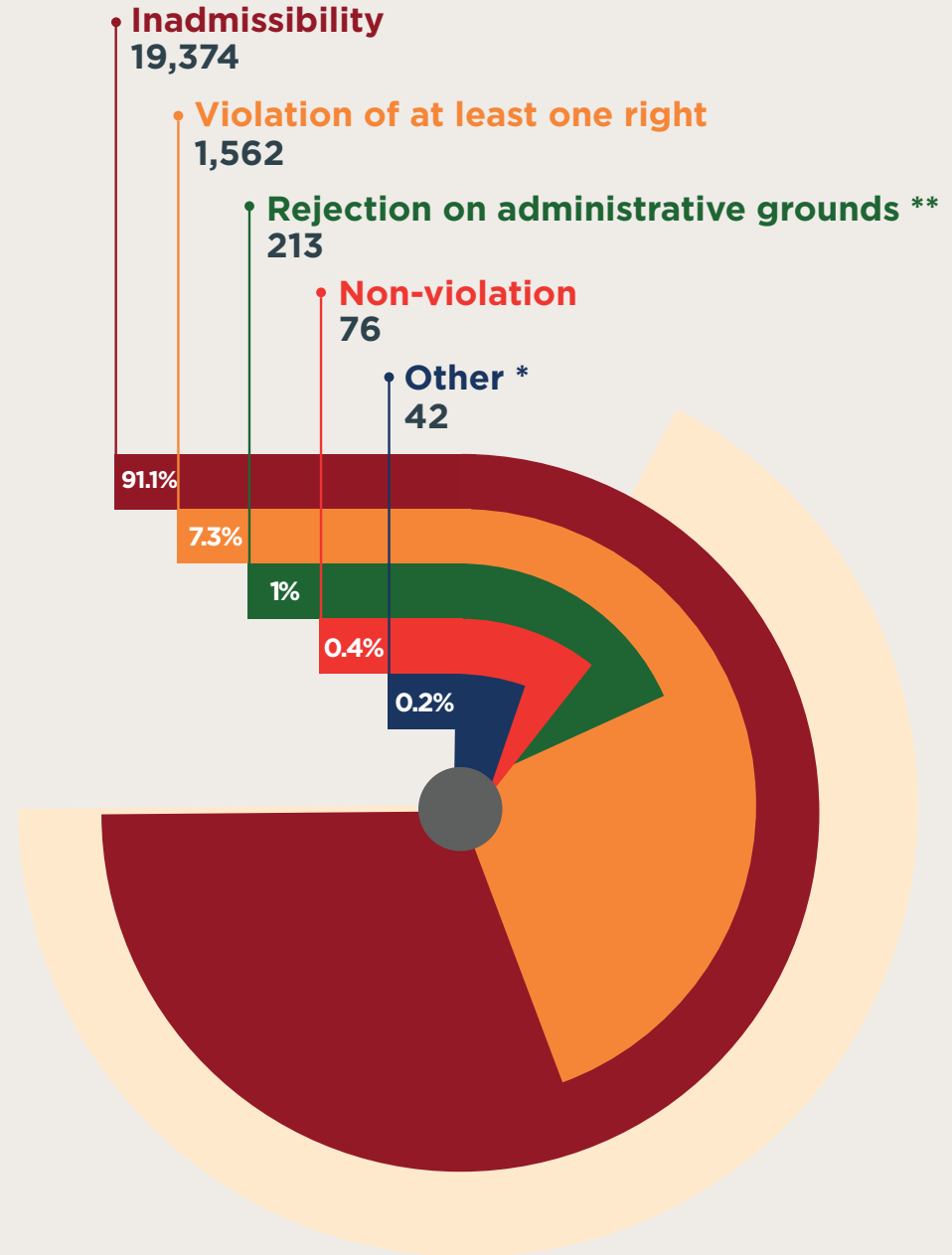

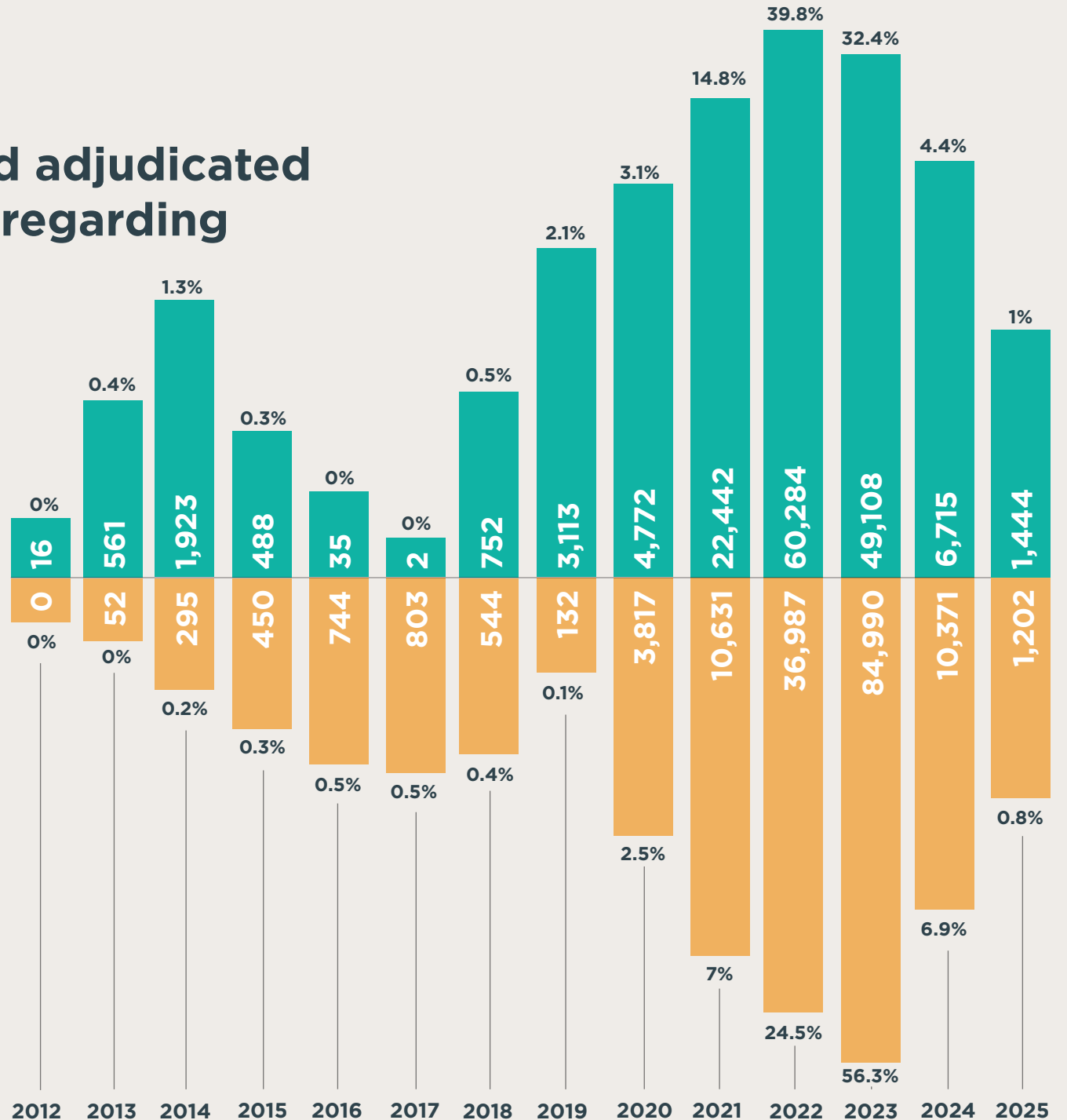

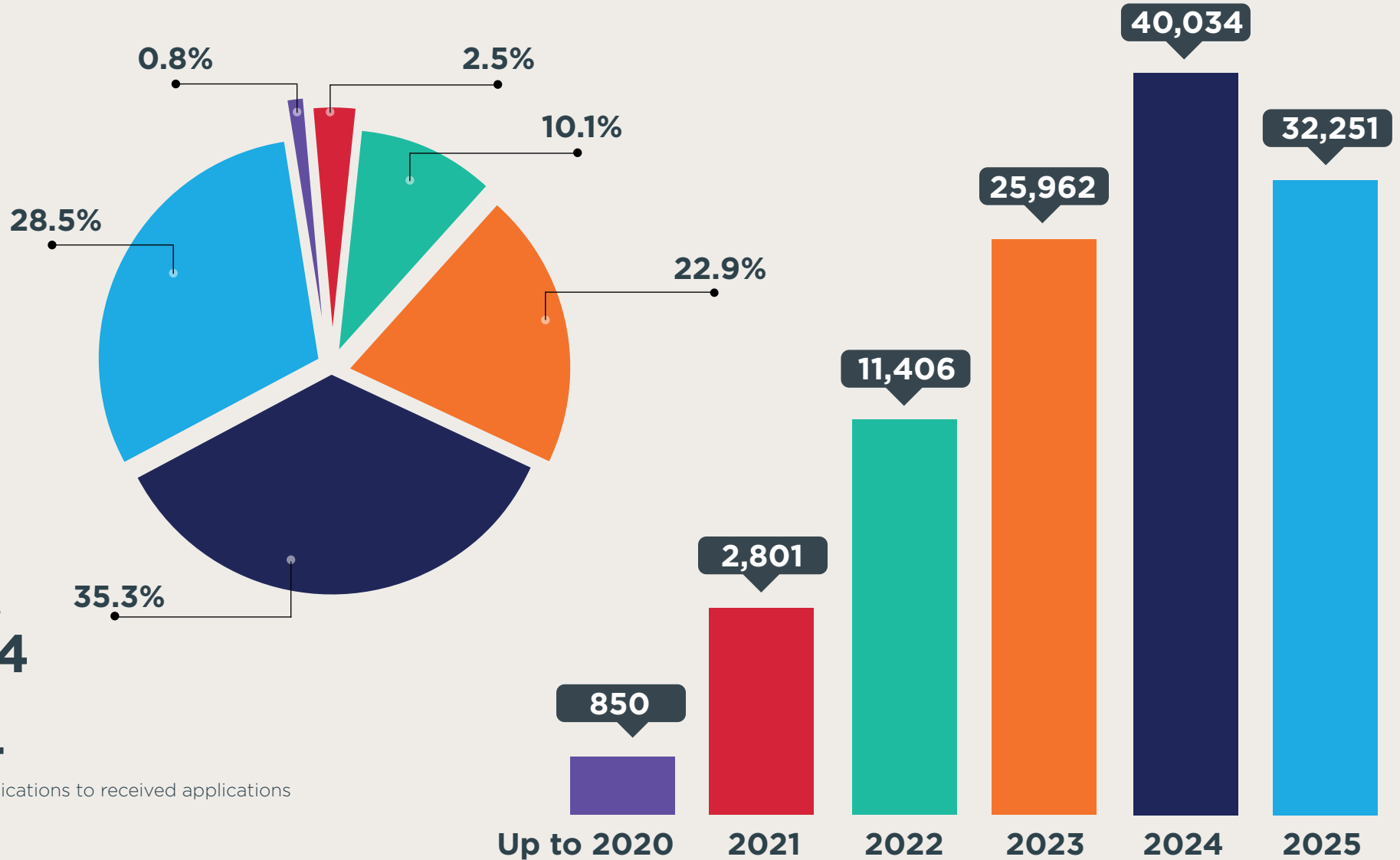

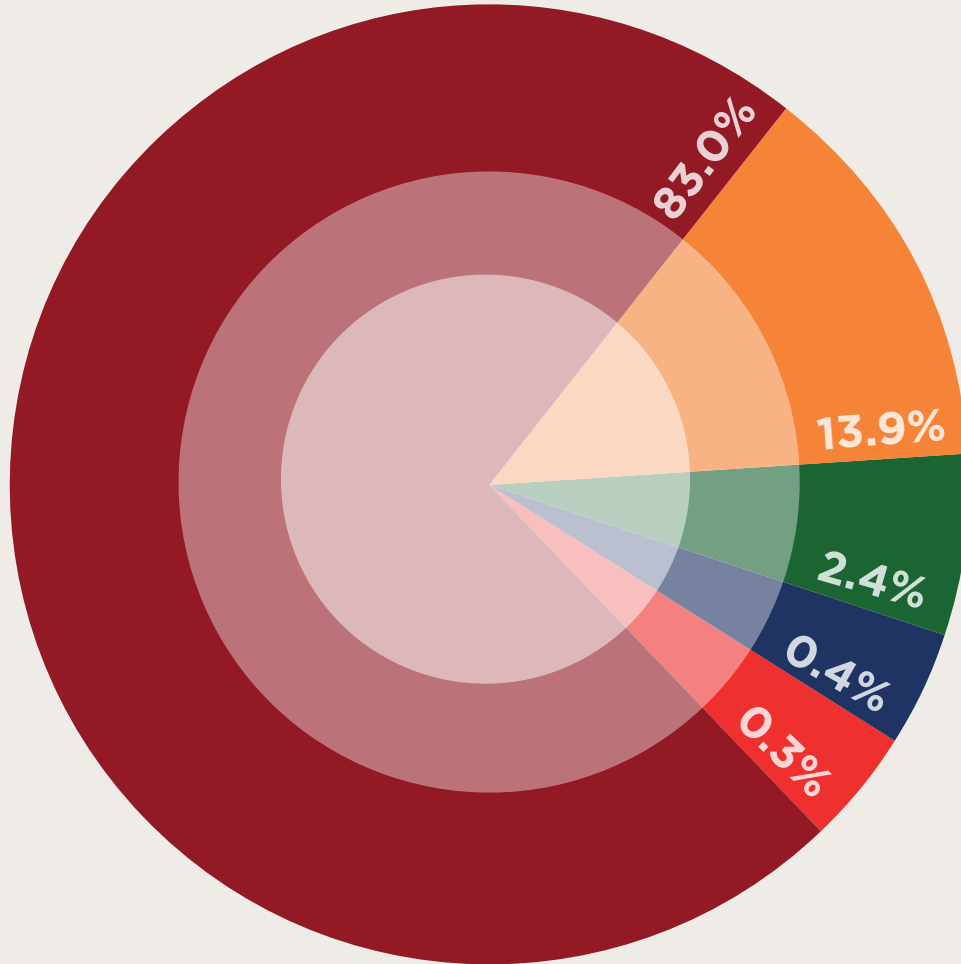

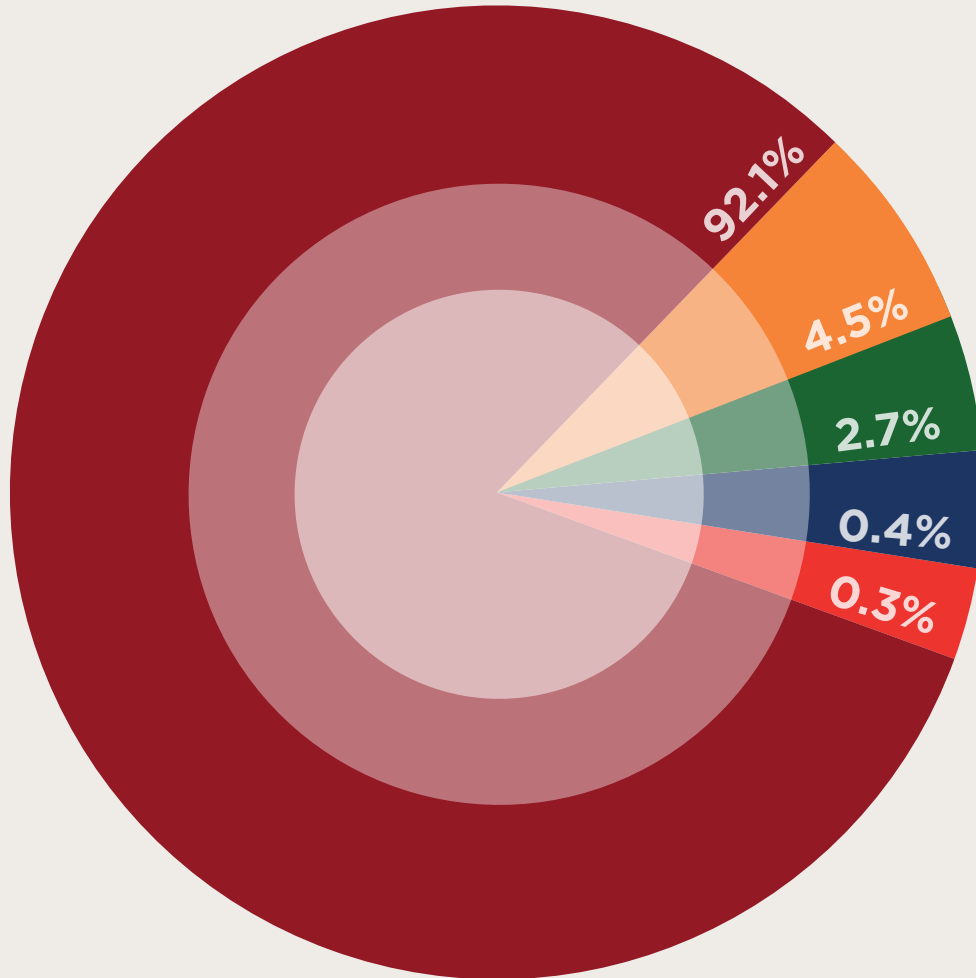

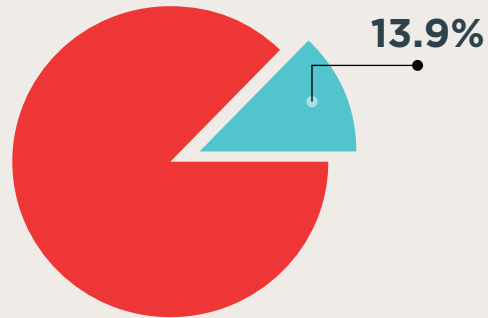

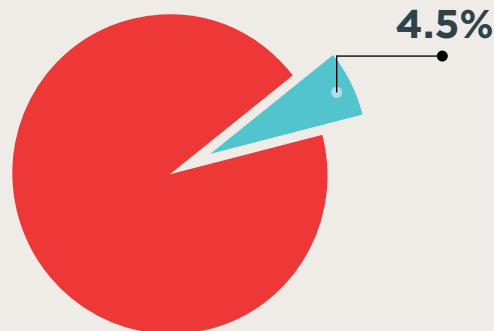

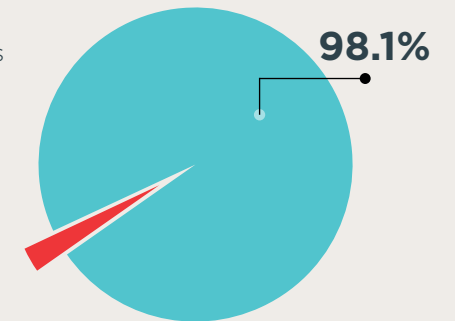

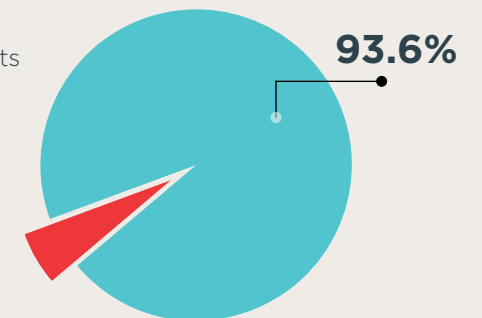

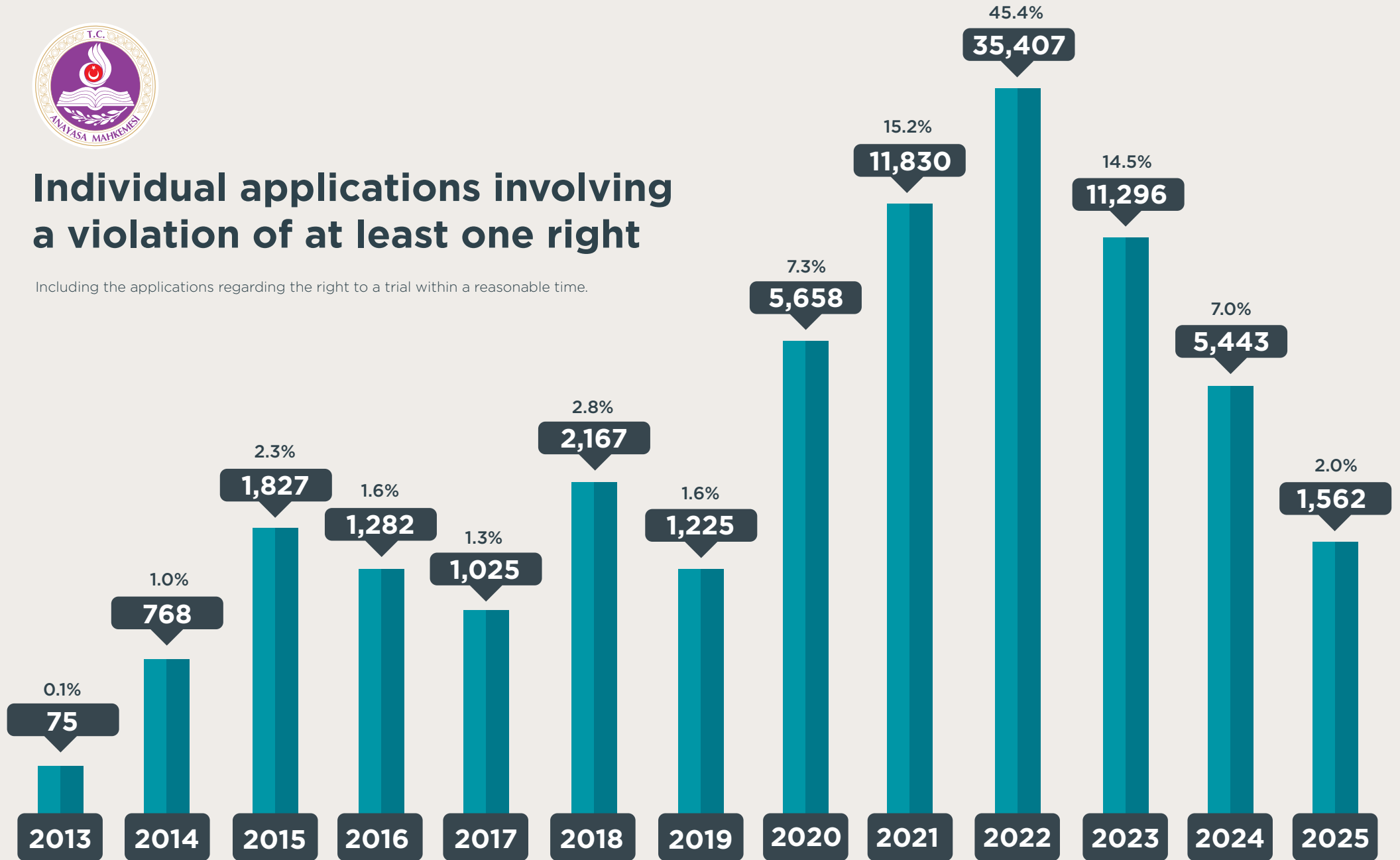

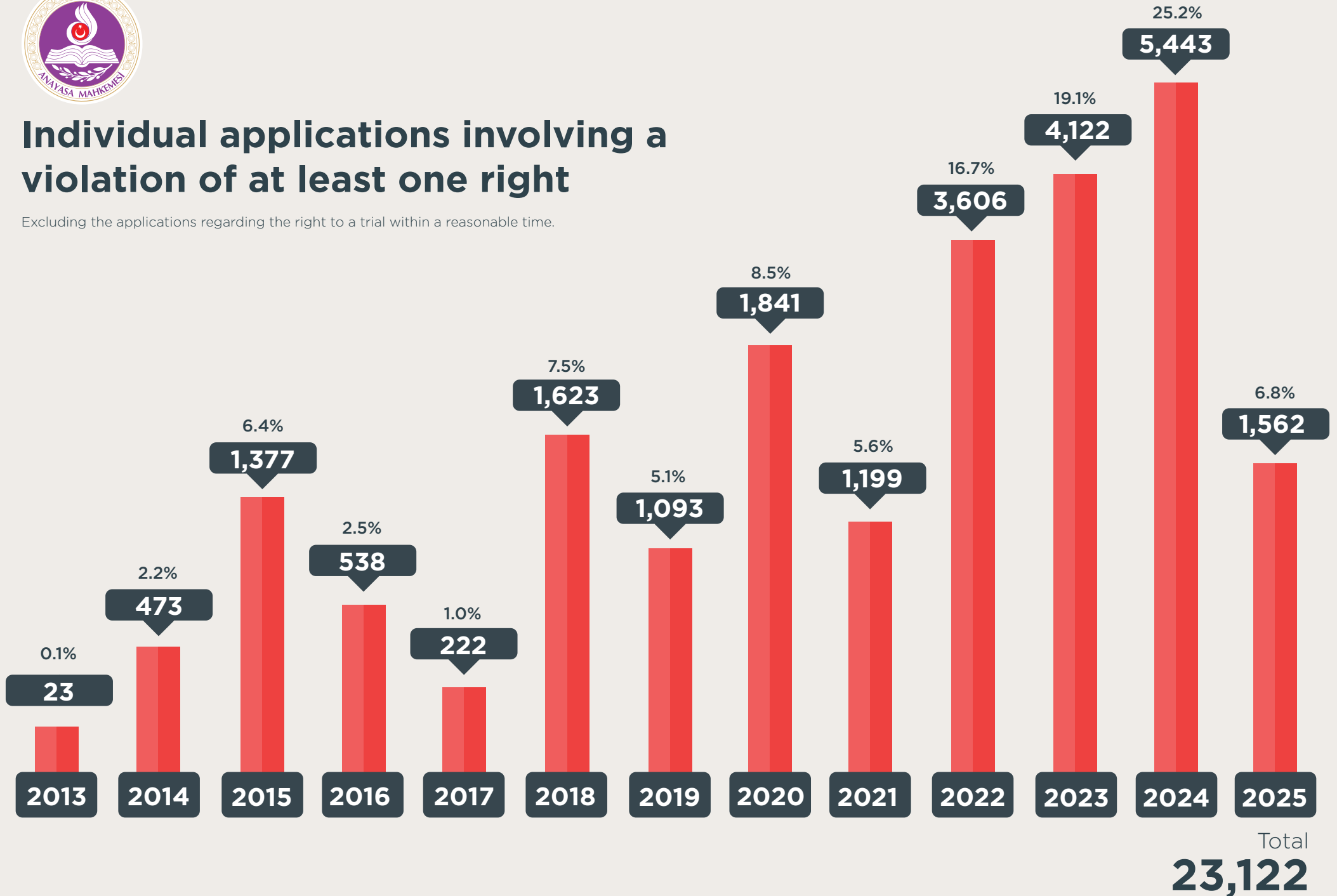

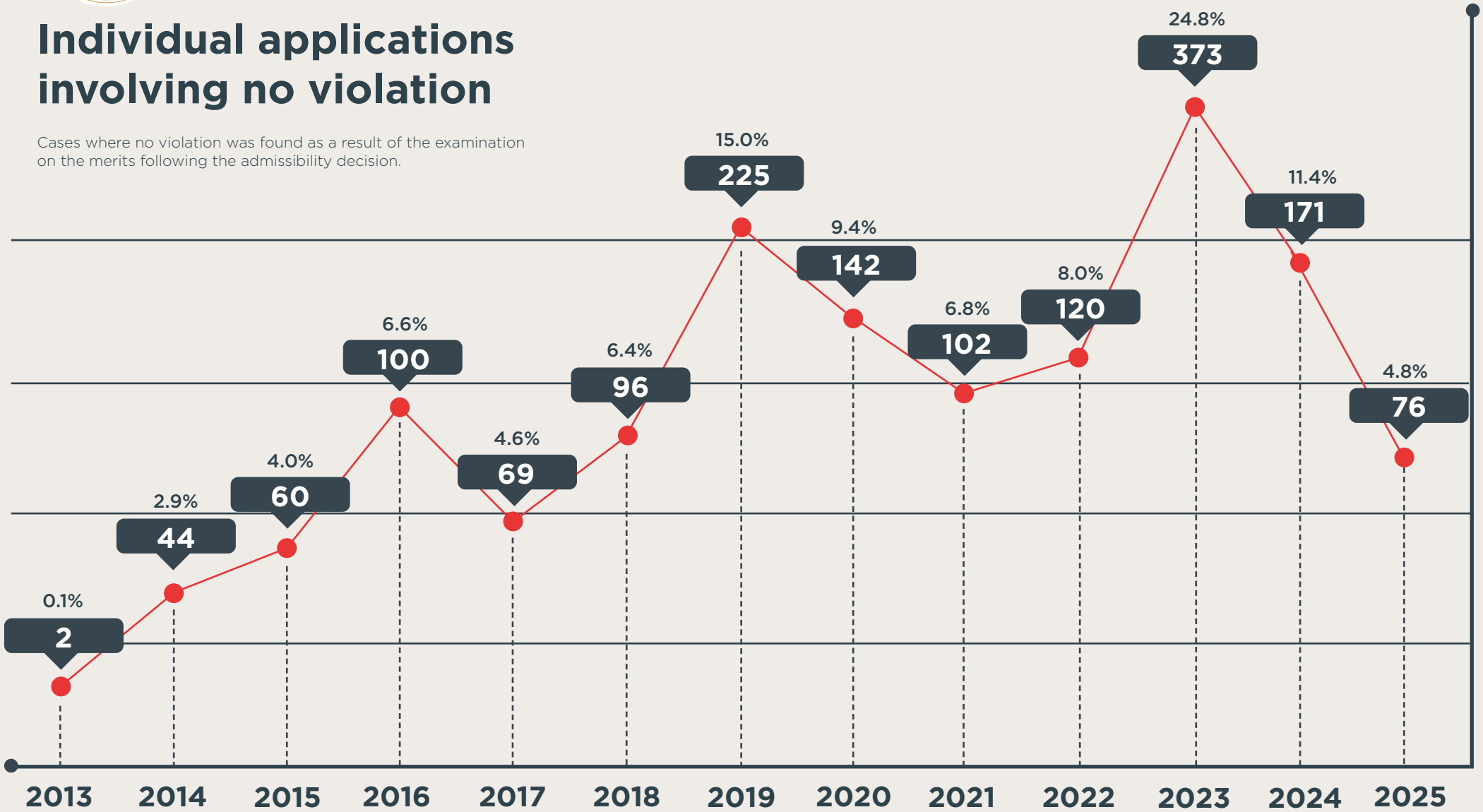

Cases where no violation was found as a result of the examination on the merits following the admissibility decision.

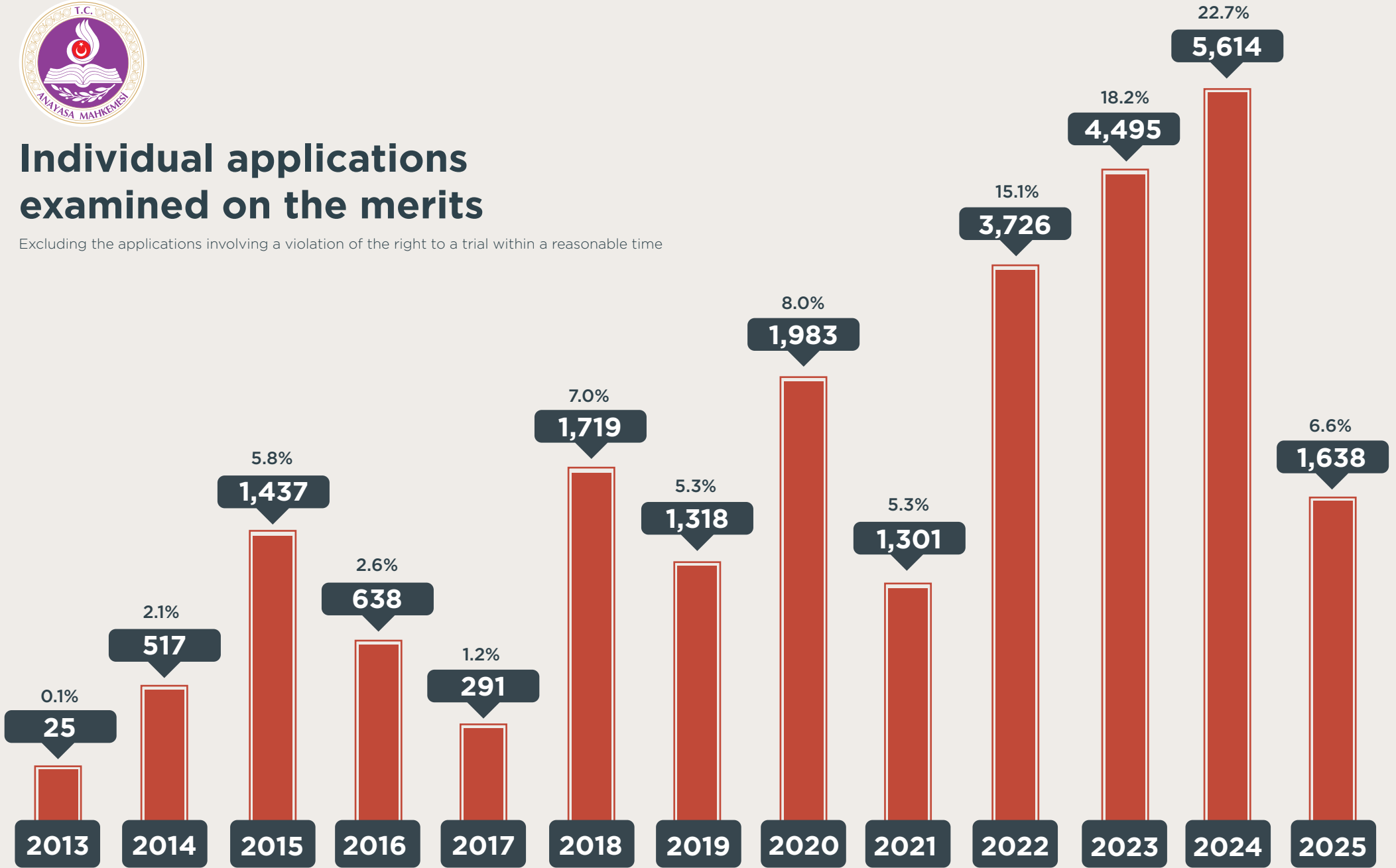
